



## Welcome to On-Demand Camps

Welcome to the DNA Learning Center's *On-Demand* Virtual Summer Science Camps! This version of our summer camps will allow you to move through a camp's curriculum at your own pace, while still enjoying hands-on lab experiences and instruction from experienced DNALC instructors.

If you are listening to this, or reading this introduction, then you are almost ready to get started...but there are a few things we would like you to know before you begin.

1. You should have received a **kit of materials**. In the kit, there are materials that are sorted into bags or labeled for each day of camp. Some of these materials may need to be refrigerated or frozen, so please make sure to read all of the instructions upon arrival. If you haven't received the kit yet, please wait to begin watching the videos.
2. You should have received an email requesting the preferred Gmail/email address so the instructor can add that email to the **Google Classroom** that has been set up for your camp. Once added, you will receive an invitation to join. Please do not use a school issued email address as they may be restricted. There are workbooks and protocols available and during camp, your instructor may reference some of these materials, so make sure they are accessible during "class time" either in digital or printed form. Some of the workbook pages are observation sheets, so if you are using them on your computer or tablet, make sure you are able to write or type on them.
3. There are sequential **recorded video lessons** for each camp. The video lessons can be accessed from the DNALC Summer Camps website ([summercamps.dnalc.org](http://summercamps.dnalc.org)), through the parent or guardian account used to purchase the *On-Demand* camp. You must be logged in to access the menu of videos. We will keep your Classroom Access code active until 60 days from the time that the camp video materials were made available to you.  
It is important that you follow along with the video lessons in order. In each camp lesson, content builds on concepts and activities from the lessons before. Failure to follow along with the video lessons in order could adversely affect your lab results.
4. We use ZOOM or Google Meet to allow campers to connect with a DNALC educator to ask questions, troubleshoot labs, and share results. Alternatively, campers can get help via email message or phone call. You can communicate with instructors using the comment function in the Google Classroom. Instructors will check and respond to comments regularly.
5. If you are taking *DNA Barcoding* or *Genome Science*, you will need to perform DNA isolations at home, and **send your samples** back to us at the DNALC for processing *right away* to avoid sample degradation. Samples must be returned by one of several specific dates for processing; instructors will provide this information in the Google Classroom. We suggest that samples be returned by overnight service. Your camp instructor will review this with you in the pre-recorded video. For *DNA Barcoding* and *Genome Science*, your lab results will also be sent to you through Google Classroom.
